

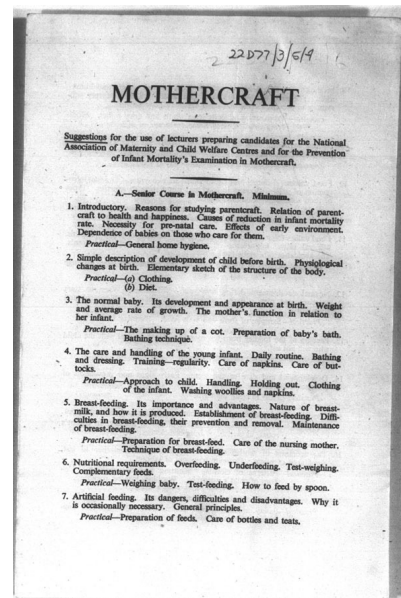
# Miriam Lord – Worksheet 1
