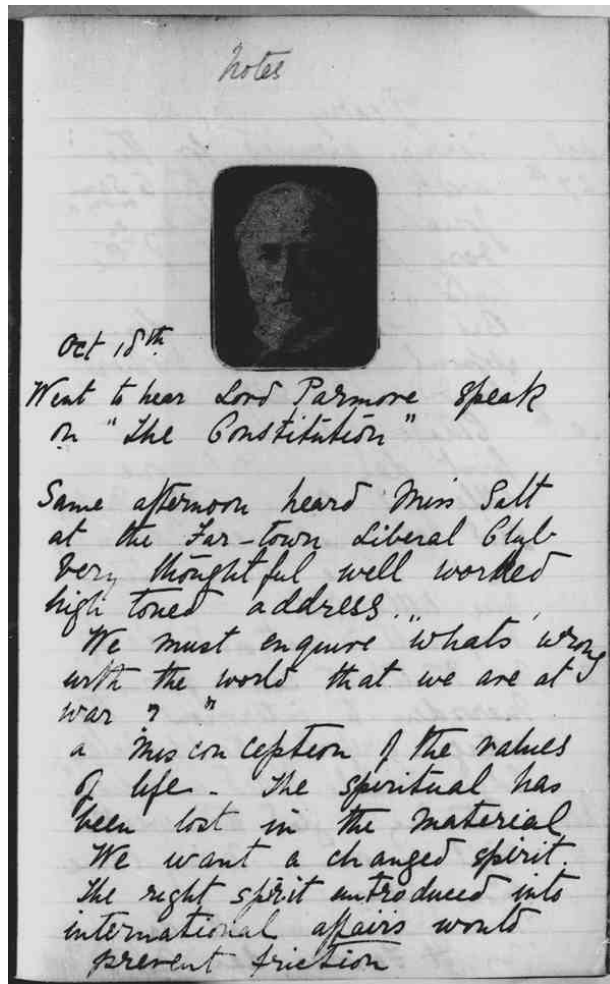


Florence Lockwood – Source 1

A misconception of the values of life. The spiritual has been lost in the material. We want a changed spirit. The right spirit introduced into International affairs would prevent friction.
