Thursday, Sept. 23. 1799
 Set out from Turbridge about Half past Ten
 Came to London a little before Seven.
 N. B. Took a Pair of Post-Horses to Swanswick but
 that Stage is so long & hilly it requires Four
 Came with my own Horses the rest of the Way.
 The Mourning for the Duke of Cumberland
 begins next Sunday.
 Friday Sept. 24th
 Dr Grantham call'd.
 Saturday, Went to Hoar's, Edwards &c.
 Sunday, Sept. 26th
 Visited Dr Alva. Went to Dr Beauchamp's
 there met Mr Yorke. She is going from
 Wimpole to Sydney Farm.
 Monday, Dr Grantham call'd, & we went
 to the House in St James Square, which is
 repairing & pending under Mr Bayfield's
 Direction, & is yet in a very unfinished State.
 Tuesday, Sept. 28th
 I went to West, set out at 1/2 past 10, got there
 before 7. Some Days in the next Week were fine.
 Monday the 4th of Oct. was a thorough rainy Day.
 Wednesday, Oct. the 6th
 Went over to my Cousins at Wimpole
